<sup>1</sup> Plans F and G also have a high deductible option which require first paying a plan deductible of \$2,700 before the plan begins to pay. Once the plan deductible is met, the plan pays 100% of covered services for the rest of the calendar year. High deductible plan G does not cover the Medicare Part B deductible. However, high deductible plans F and G count your payment of the Medicare Part B deductible toward meeting the plan deductible.

<sup>2</sup> Plans K and L pay 100% of covered services for the rest of the calendar year once you meet the out-of-pocket yearly limit.

<sup>3</sup> Plan N pays 100% of the Part B coinsurance, except for a co-payment of up to \$20 for some office visits and up to a \$50 co-payment for emergency room visits that do not result in an inpatient admission.

**Disclosures.** Use this outline to compare benefits and premiums among policies.

**Premium Information.** Mountain Health Co-Op can only raise your premium if we raise the premium for all policies like yours in the same geographic area of the state where you live.

**Read Your Policy Very Carefully.** This is only an outline describing your policy's most important features. The policy is your insurance contract. You must read the policy itself to understand all of the rights and duties of both you and us.

**Right to Return Policy.** If you find that you are not satisfied with your policy, you may return it to us at our Medicare Supplement Administrative Office P.O. Box 2209 Duncan, OK 73534-2209. If you send the policy back to us within 30 days after you receive it, we will treat the policy as if it had never been issued and return all of your payments.

**Policy Replacement.** If you are replacing another health insurance policy, do NOT cancel it until you have actually received your new policy and are sure you want to keep it.

**Exclusions.** We will not pay for loss incurred while your policy is not in force, except as provided in the Extension of Benefits section of your policy; hospital or Skilled Nursing Facility confinement incurred during a Medicare Part A Benefit Period that begins while this policy is not in force; that portion of any Loss incurred which is paid for by Medicare; services for non-Medicare Eligible Expenses, including, but not limited to, routine exams, take-home drugs and eye refractions; services for which a charge is not normally made in the absence of insurance; or loss that is payable under any other Medicare supplement insurance policy or certificate.

**Notice.** The policy may not fully cover all of your medical costs. Neither we nor our agents are connected with Medicare. This outline does not give all the details of Medicare coverage. Contact your local Social Security office or consult "Medicare & You" for more details.

**Complete Answers Are Very Important.** When you fill out the application for the new policy, be sure to answer truthfully and completely all questions about your medical and health history. We may cancel your policy and refuse to pay any claims if you leave out or falsify important medical information. **Review the application carefully before you sign it. Be certain that all information has been properly recorded.**
