



PROVIDER NETWORKS

As of January 1, 2023, the CO-OP's provider networks, broken out by state are listed below.

Montana

- Connected Care – A robust network of providers and facilities throughout Montana available to individuals and group members
- Access Care – Montana network that includes all facilities with a rich selection of providers throughout the state
- Plus - Formerly known as CO-OP Plus, a two-tier provider network product
 - Tier 1 – Participating Community Health Centers for lower office visit copays
 - Tier 2 – All other Connected Care Network providers and facilities
- Rocky Mountain – Partnership with Rocky Mountain Health Network and St. Vincent's. Offered in Yellowstone County only. Available to individuals and group members.

Idaho

- Engage – A rich network of providers available to individuals and group members
- Access Care – St. Alphonsus Health Alliance Network. Available to individual members.
- LINK – St. Luke's Health Partners Network. Available to individuals and group members

Wyoming

- High Plains – A broad network of providers. Available to individuals and group members
 - Individual Plans (Wyoming Only)
 - First Health Network for Wyoming, South Dakota, and Nebraska
